I tried leaving red velvet fudge for them, but that resulted in a squirrel **coming to visit** me.










Furthermore, I was about to lose all hope since it was the last day, but a miracle was made after the **night swim**.










It was my last night at camp, and I was **walking back to the cabin**, when I heard a faint sound coming from nearby.
